Consideration of Minutes From Prior Meetings (deferred)

The Select Board reviewed articles submitted in a draft Annual Town Meeting Warrant. They changed the warrant by deleting an article related to transfer of \$7K from the waterways fund to offset public safety. This was their only suggested change and it was agreed that following a review of the warrant by the FinCom that it would return to them for a vote.

Jim Glavin reported from the Board of Health that essentially nothing had changed since the last report. He felt that the Governor may review the time limitation on short term rentals on June 8.

Julie suggested that the BoH commence charging for drop-offs commencing on Sunday, May 24, 2020. Jim Glavin agreed that the time had come and that necessary protections for the attendant were in place.

Julie suggested that it would be okay to burn the inside of the Circle.

The Board discussed the grounding of a fishing vessel on Lobsterville Beach. It was pointed out that while the Aquinnah Police were properly notified, the Aquinnah Harbormaster was not informed of the incident. Ther was no action taken.
