## TOWN OF AQUINNAH COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS

County of Dukes County, ss. To Either of the Constables of the Town of Aquinnah

## **GREETINGS**:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of Aquinnah, qualified to vote in Town affairs to meet on the tarmac in front of the Aquinnah Fire Station in the Town of Aquinnah at 1:00 P.M. on November 14, 2020, then and there to act on the articles of this Warrant.

Article 1: To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds the sum of Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000.00) for engineering, planning and design of renovations and additions to the Town Hall and Town Offices, or take any other action relative thereto.

Article 2: To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds the sum of Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00) to construct a shed for the Harbormaster at West Basin, or take any other action relative thereto.

Article 3: To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Four Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy-Three Dollars (\$4,873.00) to pay the town's Share of the Up-Island Regional School district's roofing design project at the West Tisbury School providing for an Owner's Project manager, designer fees, and any costs incidental and relative thereto. Provided, however, the other two member Towns of the District approve their share of the total project costs of Sixty Nine Thousand Three Hundred Sixteen Dollars (\$69,316.00).

Article 4: To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Eight Thousand Three Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars and Thirty-Seven Cents (\$8,325.37) to pay the following outstanding accounts from prior year's accounts: 1. One Thousand One Hundred Four Dollars and Forty-Three Cents (\$1,104.43) to pay for materials related to repairs to the vestibule at the Town Hall; 2. One Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-Two Dollars and Thirty-Nine Cents (\$1,532,39) for repairs to the Harbormaster's boat; 3. Three Thousand Two Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars and Forty-Four Cents (\$3,248.44) for Visa account; and 4. Two Thousand Four Hundred Forty Dollars and Eleven Cents (\$2,440.11) for MWV Multi-Media Services to cover expert witness fees. (Requires 9/10 vote)

Article 5: To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) for engineering, planning and design of new restrooms at Aquinnah Circle, or take any other action relative thereto.

Article 6: To see if the Town will vote to adopt the following aspirational goal in response to the developing climate change crisis: To

- Reduce fossil fuel use on the Island (from a 2018 baseline):
  - o 50% by 2030 o 100% by 2040;

- Increase the fraction of the island's electricity use that is renewable: o To 50% by 2030
  - o To 100% by 2040; and
- Foster biosphere carbon capture through:
  - Adoption of regenerative agriculture and landscaping
  - Protection and expansion of wetlands
  - Preservation of woodland resources;

and further, to request that the Town Climate and Energy Committee annually monitor progress toward the achievement of these goals.

Article 7: To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds the sum of Ten Thousand Seventy Five Dollars (\$10,075.00) to defray expenses of Crosswater Landscape, Inc. for services provided in connection with construction of the picnic area at the Cliffs, or take any other action relative thereto.

Article 8: To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) to lay out and install a parking surface at the Town Library and repair surface of the parking area at Town Hall, or take any other action relative thereto.

Article 9: To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Nineteen Thousand One Hundred Ninety-Eight Dollars and Thirty-Two Cents (\$19,198.32) to pay for leases of town vehicles, or take any other action relative thereto.

Article 10: To see if the town will transfer from available funds the sum of Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00) for the purpose of employing a grant writer/manager for the Town, or take any other action relative thereto.

Article 11: To see of the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Twenty Four Thousand One Hundred Nineteen Dollars (\$24,119.00) to defray cleaning expenses at the Restrooms at the Cliffs, or take any other action relative thereto.

Article 12: To see if the Town will vote to appropriate monies, from current Community Preservation Undesignated Fund, for the undertaking of the following **Open Space, Recreation, Historic Preservation, and Community Housing** efforts, as recommended by the Community Preservation Committee:

Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00) for initial survey and pre-development costs related to Playground, Food Forest, and Affordable Housing on the Town Center property per planning recommendations developed by the Conway School; and,

Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00) for continued site planning related to the interior of Aquinnah Circle including, but not limited to the siting of a public bathroom building and of pathways within the circle area; and,

Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) for the ongoing restoration of the Edwin Devries Vanderhoop Homestead, or take any other action thereto.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by publishing an attested copy thereof in a newspaper having general circulation in said Aquinnah, seven days, at least, before the time of said meeting or by it posting it at the Town Hall and Old School House at least 7 days before the holding of such meeting.

HEREOF FAIL NOT, and make due return of this Warrant with doings thereon to the Town Clerk at the time and place of Meeting aforesaid.
